## McKenna Looking for Back-to-Back Victories at lowa

McKenna will first hit the track on Friday, June 18<sup>th</sup> with testing at 11:30 a.m. and 2 p.m. CT (12:30 p.m., 3 p.m. ET) with practice at 7:30 p.m. CT (8:30 p.m. ET). Qualifying is Saturday, June 19<sup>th</sup> at 9 a.m. CT (10 a.m. ET), and the race starts at 3:35 p.m. ET (4:35 p.m. CT). The Cape Motorsports with Wayne Taylor Racing team will also be competing in Firestone Indy Lights as Gustavo Yacaman will be racing the No. 10 machine at Iowa Speedway (Round 5).
